Understanding the Degrees of Glon, and Outer Darkness Suggested Marking Guide

UNDERSTANDING THE

- Turn to D&C 76. This is a record of a vision of what life is like in the 3 degrees of Glory and Outer Darkness. Look in the section heading and mark the 2 people that saw this vision.
- In the section heading, underline what Joseph was doing doing.
- ☑ (Circle) "Scriptures" and write off to the side of that: "Joseph Smith Translation of the Bible"
- ☑ Circle "Sundry" and write off to the side: Various
- ✓ Now... mark what was apparent had been taken from the Bible.
- $\overline{\mathbf{A}}$ What had Joseph figured out about "Heaven"? (Mark it)
- What was the scripture that Joseph Smith was translating, that brought this all on? circle it)
- $\overline{\mathbf{A}}$ Look up that scripture and see what it says.
- $\overline{\mathbf{A}}$ Now **cross-reference** that scripture with 1 Corinthians 15:40-42. In your scriptures write:

x-ref: | Cor | 15:40-42

- **Consider these questions:** \checkmark
 - Without knowing that there are 3 heavens or "degrees of heaven" or "degrees of glory", if you believed there was only one heaven... how bad can you be and still go to Heaven?
 - What is the cut off?
 - And how would you feel going from church to church being taught different things or requirements about who makes it to heaven and who doesn't? (Like Joseph had been).
 - Take a minute and write your thoughts on a sticky note and put it by the section heading.
- In verse 1, mark who should pay attention to this vision.
- ☑ (Circle verse 3, and write off to the side: No one can stop this vision from eventually happening
- Draw an arrow from verse 5 to verse 6.
- In verse 5, mark the 2 "those who..." statements. (the 2 qualities that describe the people who will get verse 6)

- ☑ (Circle) 'fear me" and write off to the side they fear God's judgments more than man's judgments Or in other words, they care more of what God thinks of them than what man thinks of them.
- $\overline{\mathbf{Q}}$ With light colored pencil, **Draw** a sun over verse 6
- $\overline{\mathbf{Q}}$ In **footnote 6a**, put a square around "Celestial Glory" and draw a line connecting that square to the sun you
- $\sqrt{}$ Verses 7-10 describe the kind of knowledge and wisdom a Celestial Being has. Go through and mark all the things that describes their knowledge and wisdom.
- \checkmark Next to verses 7-10, write What Gelestial Beings are like
- Verses 11-18 is **Joseph's** explanation of how this vision came to happen. Write that off to the side of those verses.
- Read through those verses and mark anything that stands out to you.
- In verse 19, circle the word "meditated" and write off to the side: a key to receiving revelation
- Draw a line under verse 19. Color that line. Write next to it

The Vision begins

- Mark the 2 people that Joseph and \checkmark Sidney see in verse 20!
- Mark who else they see in verse 21.
- When Joseph was writing this vision, he stops and makes an important statement in verses 22-24. Put a big square around all 3 of those verses.
- $\overline{\mathbf{A}}$ Mark in verse 22 what their testimony of Christ is.
- Off to the side, write **Christ** is not dead. He lives!

OUTER DARKNESS

- Now Joseph will start teaching about Outer darkness and the 3 degrees of Glory.
- Draw a line under verse 24, and another line under verse 49. At the beginning of this section of verses, write:
 - Lucifer and Outer Darkness

- Draw an **X** or a **O** next to **each** of those verses.
- Go back to verse 25. Write **Lucifer** next to that verse.
- **Underline** everything you learn about him in that verse.
- Make sure you mark how Heavenly Father felt about him
- In verse 26, Circle Lucifer. Off to the side write His name means light-bearer and indicates he was in a position of authority there
- ☑ Now circle "**Perdition**" and write off to the side: "Means LOST.

Those who had perfect knowledge of God and rejected Him."

- Mark in verses 26 and 27 how we felt when this happened.
- After those verses, write:

x-ref: Moses 4: I-4

- ☑ Get a color you haven't used to mark with yet, and mark in verse 28 "While we were vet in the Spirit, the Lord commanded us that we should write". Now mark that same message in verses: 49, 80, and 113.
- Go back to verse 28 and write next to it "We should write down our impressions WHILE we are receiving them"
- In verse 28, mark all of Lucifer's names.
- **<u>Underline</u>** in that verse, what he is seeking to do.
- In verse 29, mark how he is trying to accomplish his goal.
- Next to that verse, write: x-ref Moses 7:26
- Mark in verse 30 what you will see in those that he actually overcomes
- Next to verses 31 and 31, write: "How people become PERDITION"
- Mark in those verses what it takes to become Perdition, like Lucifer.
- Mark the sad reality in verse 32.
- <u>Underline</u> all of the things you learn about Sons of Perdition in verses 33-
- Put a box around "go away into the lake of fire and brimstone with the devil and his angels-" and next to that, write "Outer Darkness/Hell"



☑ In verse 37, circle "Second Death".
Off to the side, write:

First (spiritual death) = The Fall Second (spiritual death)= Outer Darkness/Hell

- ☑ In verse 38, <u>underline</u>: shall not be redeemed. Then draw an arrow from "redeemed" to the space above and write "**spiritually redeemed**"
- Put a sun, moon and star next to verses 39, and write: The 3 degrees of Glory
 - ☑ Highlight the edge of verses 40-43
 - Put a box around "This is the gospel" in vrese 40.
 - Draw arrows from that box to verses 41 and 42.
 - Next to those verses, write "What Perdition KNOWS but openly rejects"
 - ✓ In verse 43 circle the word "After", and write next to it "they know"
 - ✓ Next to verse 44, write "Hell"
 - ✓ Mark all the things you learn about Hell in verse 44
 - At the end of that verse write "constant suffering"
 - Read verses 45-48 where the Lord explains that we will never understand what Outer Darkness is like. Mark the parts that stand out to you. And write off to the side "we will never understand".

CELESTIAL KINGDOM

- **☑ Draw a line** under verse 70
- ✓ At the beginning of this section of verses (so by verse 50), write **Gelestial Kingdom**
- ☐ Draw a (sun) next to each of the verses starting at 50 all the way through 70. (So draw 20 little suns)
- ☑ In verse 50, highlight what kind of resurrection these people will have.
- ☑ In the white space at the end of verse 50, write A "Just" man is and then draw an arrow from that statement to verse 51.
- Now, in verses 50-53, make a list of all of the things Celestial Beings did on Earth. Number them as you find them. So start by putting a next to "who received a testimony of Jesus"
- Now put a box around verses 54-59. By that box write "**Gelestial Life**"
- At the end of verse 58, write "My Divine Nature"
- ☐ Then in **footnote 58a**, **highlight** "Exaltation; Man, Potential to

- Become Like Heavenly Father" and draw a line connecting that phrase to where you wrote "My Divine Nature"
- ✓ Mark the promise in verse 60
- Now mark all of the promises for Celestial Beings in verses 61-69
- ☑ In verse 66, circle Mount Zion, and write off to the side **New Jerusalem**
- \square Draw a sun over the entire verse 70 \triangleright

TERRESTRIAL KINGDOM

- ☑ Now **draw** a line under verse 80.
- At the beginning of this section of verses, write **Terrestrial Kingdom** (so by verse 71)
- ☑ **Draw** a (moon) by **each** of these verses (so starting at 71 all the way through 80)
- ☑ In verse 71, mark how different the glory of Terrestrial beings are from Celestial beings
- ✓ Next to that verse write: x-ref | Gorinthians | 15:4|
- ✓ Now go through verses 72-75 and mark the things you learn about those who go to the Terrestrial Kingdom
- ☑ In verse 76 and 77, mark whose presence they will and will not be able to be in.
- ☑ Draw a moon over verse 79
- Mark verse 79. This is the great difference between them and Celestial beings.
- ☑ Circle the word valiant and write next to it: carried out with courage or determination

TELESTIAL KINGDOM

- ☑ Now **draw a line** under verse 90
- At the beginning of this section of verses (so by verse 81) write:

 Telestial Kingdom
- ☐ Draw a (star) next to each verse in this section EXCEPT verse 87
- ☑ In verse 81, mark how Telestial beings are different than the other kingdoms
- ☑ Draw a star over that verse
- ✓ Mark what you learn about Telestial beings in verses 82-85.
- Mark which member of the Godhead they can be in the presence of in verse 86.
- ✓ <u>Underline</u> who can minister to them in verse 86.

- ✓ Mark who can minister to Terrestrial beings in verse 87.
- ☑ Draw a moon next to verse 87.
- ☑ In verse 88, mark that telestial beings are "heirs of salvation"
- ☑ In verse 89, mark how glorious the Telestial Kingdom is.
- ☑ In verse 90, **highlight** who understands the glory of the Telestial Kingdom

TERRESTRIAL KINDOM

- ☑ In verse 91, <u>underline</u> all the ways the Terrestrial Kingdom exceeds the Telestial Kingdom
- ☑ Put a moon next to that verse

CELESTIAL KINGDOM

- ☑ In verses 92-95, mark all the things the Celestial Kingdom has that the other kingdoms don't have.
- ☑ Draw suns next to verses 92-96
- ✓ Draw one sun over verse 96



TERRESTRIAL KINGDOM

☐ Draw one moon over verse 97 and a little moon next to it

TELESTIAL KINGDOM

- Draw many stars over verse 98.

 Make the stars different sizes.
- ☑ Put a **star** next to verses 98-112
- ✓ Next to verse 99, write "they followed men instead of God"
- ✓ Mark the footnote in verse 99
- ✓ Next to verse 100 and 101 write "they didn't except Christ's Gospel, but rather many churches teachings"
- Mark what will **NOT** happen in verse 102
- Mark all of the qualities you learn about Telestial beings in verse 103
- Mark what will happen to them in verses 104-106
- Mark what must happen before they are redeemed from Hell (which is the last-resurrection) in verses 107-108.
- Circle how many Telestial Beings he saw in the vision (verse 109)
- ✓ Mark what will eventually happen to ALL MEN in verse 110
- Draw a Sun, a moon and a star next to verse 11 and highlight the parts in that verse that stand out to you
- ☑ <u>Underline</u> what Telestial beings cannot do in verse 112
