

WEEKLY POSTERS

NATIVITY ACTIVITY

PAGES 10-11

For a wonderful Christmas activity, do the following:

- 1. Print the Christmas poem, cut down the center along the gray dotted line. Fold in half so the poem stands like a tent with the illustration on the front and the activity instructions on the back.
- 2. Print the weekly cards (make several copies of this page). Cut into individual cards.
- 3. Set the poem and the cards in or by your nativity.
- 4. At the beginning of December, read the poem to your family and explain each week's service focus. Each time they do an act of service, invite them to get a card for that week, write what they did, and place it in the nativity. Over the month of December, the pile of cards should grow.
- 5. On Christmas Eve, Christmas day, or another time, read through all of the cards and talk about the experiences everyone had. Discuss how serving others impacted their Christmas this year and how it strengthened their relationship with the Savior.
