DOCTRINE & COVENANTS 19

The Book of Mormon translation was complete. A problem arose with publishing it. Martin Harris agreed to mortgage 150 acres of his prosperous farm to pay for printing it. When the time came to pay, Martin became nervous he would lose his farm. He asked Joseph for a blessing. Doctrine & Covenants 19 is the result.

DOCTRINE & COVENANTS 19:1-12

MARK the title of Jesus and what you learn about Him. Label verses 6–12 “eternal punishment is God’s punishment.”

DOCTRINE & COVENANTS 19:13-20

MARK the word “repent.”

DOCTRINE & COVENANTS 19:18-19

MARK what Jesus says about His atoning sacrifice. What did Martin learn about sacrifice from the Lord?

Jesus sacrificed His life. Martin sacrificed his farm to publish the Book of Mormon. What are we willing to sacrifice to make their sacrifices worthwhile?

BOOK OF MORMON CONNECTION: What does the Book of Mormon teach about Christ’s suffering during the Atonement? Alma 7:11–13

THE ATONEMENT OF JESUS CHRIST

The Savior’s Atonement is a miracle. We do not know exactly what He experienced during His infinite sacrifice. Scriptures give us brief windows into His suffering and sacrifice.

Amulek explained that an atonement must be made, and then described what the sacrifice was not and what it was (Alma 34:9–10). Doctrine & Covenants 19:18–19 is the only firsthand account of the Savior describing His suffering. In Alma 7:11–13, the Prophet Alma indicates some categories of suffering experienced by Christ in the Atonement.
