KIDS TABLE POSTER

You can use this poster in so many ways! We call it a table poster because it is designed to sit in an acrylic frame and be left out on a table so your child can read it in the same way they might look at the back of a cereal box. You can also hang it on the fridge or a bathroom mirror or wherever your kids are when they have a few minutes with nothing to do. It's a great way to introduce independent learning.

You can also use it for lesson planning, or give it to an older child to plan a short family devotional. Every week our kit comes with a children's poster and a teen poster.

This added power will allow them to perform the same miracles they witnessed Jesus accomplish. Imagine the emotions running through these Apostles as they make their way to their first mission! Carrying little physical possessions was not a worry. They knew the Lord would freely give to them as they freely gave to others.
