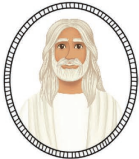
Living Commandments Will Help Me Know They Are True

- ☐ Have you ever heard of the word "doctrine"? Do you know what doctrine is? Give your best answer or guess below:

DOCTRINE IS...

- ☐ Doctrines are unchanging and eternal truths. For example, here are two doctrines:



Heavenly Father is the Father of your spirit



Jesus Christ was the first person on earth to be resurrected

- ☐ Let's imagine that a boy named Juan does not believe those things in the above blue boxes. Since those things are DOCTRINES, that means they are true and unchanging. So this means that Juan is not able to see what is true. Heavenly Father IS the father of Juan's spirit, but Juan does not know it.



- ☐ The more doctrines you learn, the more you will understand Heavenly Father and His plan for you. Also, Satan will have a hard time deceiving and tricking you because you are FULL OF TRUTH!



Jesus taught you something you can do to know that doctrines are true. Turn to John 7:17.

- ☐ Make the following markings in John 7:17:

- 1 Circle the words "do his will" and by it write "obey God's commandments."

- 2 Circle the "doctrine" and by it write "eternal, unchanging truths."

- ☐ Now look up at verse John 7:14 and mark where Jesus was teaching at this time.

- ☐ While Jesus was teaching, the people were surprised at how well He knew the doctrines. Mark the question the Jews asked in John 7:15.



It was the Jewish rabbis and scribes that would teach people in the temple and they had gone through a lot of schooling. The people were wondering how Jesus knew so much without the same schooling the others had.

- ☐ Now read verse 17 again. Jesus was teaching that you do not have to go to a fancy school to learn Heavenly Father's doctrine. Anyone can learn it, but they must do what Heavenly Father wants them to do in order to understand the doctrine.

- ☐ For example: Here is one of Heavenly Father's doctrines:



The Sabbath Day is a holy and sacred day.

- ☐ Does everyone on earth know and believe this doctrine? (color in the answer)

- ☐ If you answered "no" you are right. Many people do not know that doctrine, but it is still TRUE. In John 7:17, Jesus is teaching that the only way to really understand why the Sabbath Day is holy is to treat it like a holy day. As you keep the Sabbath Day holy, your testimony and understanding of the Sabbath Day will grow and grow.
