## **MATTHEW 4:18-22**

#### TO PREPARE:

- 1. Print this page and the next page onto white cardstock.
- 2. Cut out all the fish.
- 3. Make a fishing pole by tying a string onto the end of a stick. Tie a paperclip onto the end of the string.
- Set up a blue blanket over a table. 4.

### TO TEACH:

- 1. Tell the story of Jesus calling Peter, Andrew, James, and John along the seashore of Galilee. You can also show the video linked in the QR code.
- 2. Explain what it means to be "fishers of men" instead of fish (they would spend their time teaching others about Jesus instead of catching fish).
- 3. Explain that we can also be fishers of men. On each fish is something children can do to help others learn about Jesus. Let each child take a turn fishing for a fish by tossing their fishing line over to the other side of the table (then you clip a fish to the paperclip).
- 4. The child then sees their fish and everyone can then act out specific ways they can do what is written on the fish.
