FINDING THE BOOK OF MOSES

Can you find the Book of Moses in your scriptures? Here's a hint! The Book of Moses is in the Pearl of Great Price, which is located behind your Doctrine and Covenants!

WHAT IS THE BOOK OF MOSES?



The Book of Moses is part of the "JST" (also known as Joseph Smith Translation) of the Bible. During his lifetime, Joseph Smith went through the Bible and restored many truths that were lost. When Joseph was working on Gen. 1:1- Gen. 6:13, he compiled the truths that were lost to create the Book of Moses.



MARKING YOUR SCRIPTURES

Circle every time that God told Moses that he was God's son. You can find these verses in Moses 1:4 and Moses 1:6-7.

MOSES SAW GOD

In this chapter, the Lord spoke to Moses face-to-face. The Lord taught Moses who He was and showed Moses a vision. After the Lord left, Satan appeared to Moses and tried to deceive him. The Lord then appeared again to Moses and showed Moses another vision of the earth and every person who will live upon the earth.





Moses Speaks to God Face to Face



God chose a man named Moses to be a prophet. Moses saw God and talked with Him face to face and saw His great glory. God told Moses that He had a work for him to do and that he was His son.

Parents: Open up to Moses 1 in your scriptures so your child can see the Book of Moses. Help them find his name.

What do you think it would have been like to see and talk to Heavenly Father face to face? How would you feel if He called you "My son/daughter"?



Soon after Moses' visit with God, Satan appeared. Satan tried to get Moses to worship him. Moses could tell the difference between God's light and power and Satan's power so Moses told Satan to leave, but Satan refused. Satan had an ugly tantrum. Moses asked God for strength and commanded Satan to leave in the name of Jesus Christ. Satan then left.

Point to Satan. Give him a big thumbs down!

What difference did Moses notice between seeing God and seeing Satan? Why is that important to you?



God appeared to Moses again after Satan left and He showed Moses a vision that included every part of the whole earth. It was amazing! Moses asked God how the earth was made. He was told that Jesus Christ, the Son of God created the earth and everything on it.

Can you show me what shape the earth is with your hands? What are some of your favorite creations?

What part of God's creations are most beautiful to you? What do those beautiful creations teach you about God?



Moses asked God why He created the earth. God said, "This is my work and my glory--to bring to pass the immortality and eternal life of man." God's whole purpose is to help us have immortality (which is to receive a glorified, resurrected body that cannot feel pain, get sick, or die). God also wants to give us eternal life (which is to live with Heavenly Father and become like Him through Jesus Christ).

Parents: Bear your testimony about God's plan.

Why does Heavenly Father want us to receive immortality and eternal life? What are those two things? Do you want them?

Have your children create their own paper dolls and act out the story in Moses 1, and you could even ask them to teach the story to the whole family! They can use the illustrated stories to decide what paper dolls to create, but here is a list to get them started:

- Moses God (full of glory)
- Satan (no glory) The Earth

Compare the experience Moses had in Moses I to the experience Joseph Smith had in the Sacred Grove. What was similar? What was different? What does this teach you about different ways God communicates? What does this teach you about Satan and his purposes?

Ask your children to learn and act out the story of "The Ugly Duckling." Together, read and discuss the story of Moses 1 and then watch this video by Elder Uchtdorf.

Go somewhere where you can see a lot of stars. When you are there, discuss together the lessons in Moses 1 and Abraham 3. Help your children understand how the universe testifies of the greatness and glory of God (see study pages for help).

DIGGING DEEPER

8-Ask a parent to write you a letter about what it means that you are a child of God.

9-Do you have another idea?

Independent learning

Print the poster back-to-back and place in an upright acrylic sign holder (available on Amazon). Place it on the counter and your children can read as they eat, like they might look at a cereal box.



Lesson Planning

- The poster is full of excellent resources for you to look through as you teach your family or class. You can look it over and decide which videos, activities, etc. you would like to use.

- Give the poster to a child and ask them to look over it and plan a lesson for your family. Tell them they can use resources from the poster and also add their own thoughts, personal experiences, and anything else they would like to add.

2. Once cut out, cut along the lines up to the black rim of the circle.

3. Use a pin to poke holes through each star.

4. Put the circle up to the end of the toilet paper roll (with the dark side facing INTO the roll) and fold down the cut edges around the toilet paper roll.

5. Hold in place by putting the rubber band around the folded parts of the circle.. You could tape it down too.
