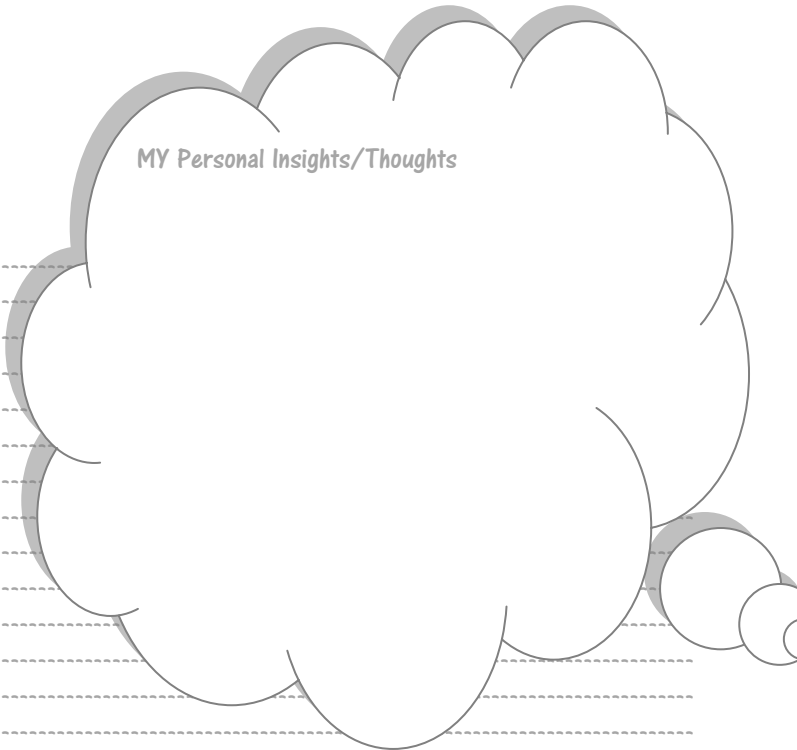
- He was born August 5, 1922 in Logan, Utah

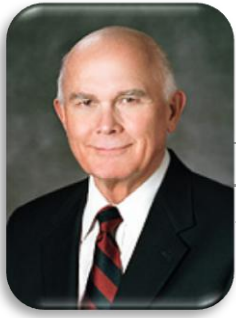
- He was born September 9, 1924 in Salt Lake City, Utah
